In response to the Caroline County Commissioners declaration of a local state emergency regarding the COVID-19 pandemic, the Mayor and Council have decided to close the Federalsburg Town Office to the public as of Wednesday, March 18, 2020 until further notice.

If you need to pay a bill during this time, please place your payment in the drop box located outside of the Town Office.

Until further notice, all Mayor and Council meetings will be conducted virtually via teleconference, live streaming, or any other available technology that will allow the necessary parties to participate and the public to observe in real time to the extent required by law.

The Public Works personnel will continue to perform all normal activities but have been requested to reduce their community interactions. Please assist the personnel by keeping your distance.

We apologize for any inconvenience this may cause. Our first priority is the health of our citizens and our staff. In an effort to prevent infection of COVID-19, please remember to take the following precautions:

- Wash your hands frequently with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. If soap and water are not available, use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer with at least 60 percent alcohol.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth with unwashed hands.
- Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
- Stay home when you are sick or when you think you are.
- Cover your cough or sneeze with your elbow or a tissue, then throw the tissue directly in the trash and wash your hands.
- Clean and disinfect frequently-touched objects and surfaces using a regular household cleaning spray or wipe.
- Practice social distancing.
- Avoid social gatherings.
- Limit nonessential travel.
