CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT AND INSPECTION SERVICES**

The Town of Federalsburg, Maryland (the "Town") is requesting proposals for Construction Management and Inspection Services and a Resident Project Representative to serve as the Owner's Site Representative for the Town's construction of the Federalsburg WWTP Upgrade to Conserve Energy, consisting of, but not limited to, the civil site work consisting of furnishing all labor, equipment, and materials for the construction of a solar farm, and the furnishing of all labor, equipment, and materials for the installation of an 800 kW Solar Power Generation System that includes panels, tacking, racking foundations, all DC electrical devices and wiring, and the required interconnect agreement with the Utility Provider (the "Project"). The Project was designed by Rauch, Inc. and has received grant funding from the Maryland Department of the Environment ("MDE") under the Energy Water Infrastructure Program ("EWIP") Grant. The Town is seeking a Construction Management and Inspection firm having the qualifications and specific experience in the successful completion of this type of construction management and which submits a responsive and responsible proposal.
